Choice of Elective Subjects for 2011-12 Secondary 4 NSS Curriculum (Phase 2)

According to the New Senior Secondary (NSS) structure which has already commenced from September 2009 in Hong Kong, all S4 students will be offered subjects of different natures which may suit their abilities and interests. That means, no more specific Science or Art streaming will be maintained. With the results from the Choice of Elective Subjects (Phase 1), the School intends to offer the subjects listed in the reply slip below for S4 students in 2011-12.

The School will allocate students to **2 different elective subjects** with reference to the following criteria:-

- ✧ Students' academic abilities and performances;
- ✧ Students' interests and preferences;
- ✧ Teachers' recommendations on students;
- ✧ Available resources in school (e.g. Only electives with more than 15 students will be offered).

At this stage, we would like to draw parents' attention to the decision of your child's NSS elective subjects. They have to try their best to look for information and consult their teachers or parents for more information so as to make their right decision. Please remind your child to be proactive and serious during the entire process. Then, please complete the form below and instruct your child/ward to submit it to his/her class teachers **during the period 11th May – 13th May 2011**. **The school will allocate students who do not submit their forms or who submit late randomly**.
