4 Major Focuses

We arrange our guidance works in **Four Categories** as follows:

A. Administration

- (1) Seminars and workshops
We hope that each member can attain at least one in the guidance field. Team members can apply through EMB services or assigned by the Team Leader.
- (2) Record of students’ services including voluntary services, services in school, flag sale etc.. See details in the following part.
- (3) Assessment of student attitudes – We will conduct the surveys of “attitude to school”, and “value” in March and May in order to collect all data from all forms.
- (5) Study handbooks
- (5) JUPAS – We assist S7 class teachers to help students to apply JUPAS and provide school recommendations to each student.
- (6) Linkage to NGO
- (7) Maintain activities in School Homepage

B. Preventive Programs

- (1) “PATHS” Positive Adolescent Training through Holistic Social Programmes” is mainly organised by school social worker and our guidance teachers.

(2) Drugs Education / Sex Education / Civic & Moral Education / Health Education – Small group workshops are more effective and the following table summaries the workshops in the coming year.

C. Developing Programs

(1) Careers Guidance

- (i) In October, we will arrange a JUPAS talk to S7 students.
- (ii) In February, we will invite IVE to give a talk to S5 and S7 students.
- (iii) We will arrange talks about Careers Talk for Non-Chinese Students in January.

(3) Student Appreciation Project – It will be carry on but the prize and nomination method should be changed.

(4) Scholarships –

- (i) Sir Edward Youde Memorial Prizes for S5 and S7 students who are good at academics;

 - (iii) Harmony Scholarship of Government Secretariat Home Affairs Bureau for two most outstanding students who are good at all aspects.
 - (iv) Outstanding Students
- (5) Adventure based counselling – Adventure-ship or ABC camping

D. Compensation Programs

(1) Financial Problem of students – We provide “Student Emergency Fund” sponsored by School Directors.

(2) Individual’s counselling – At least five cases in a year with written records.

E. Services Learning Programs

- 1. The school services teams are exempted likes prefects, road safety patrol, scouts, community youth club, junior police call, and monitors etc..
- 2. School has the right to accept the kinds of recognized services. Students must present the proven records for the external services. (see attached sheets)

3. The recognized services can be flag sale, voluntary services in social welfare centers, school activity helper, external activity helper, and other meaningful services.
4. Award Scheme
 - (a) Student finishes 20 services hours who can get Bronze badge, 40 services hours get Silver badge, and 80 services hours get Gold badge.
 - (b) Students can keep all badges themselves.
 - (c) This is an annual award scheme.
 - (d) Certificates will be presented in ceremony.
 - (e) The services hours can be accumulated in student's school records and students can check in their account in Websams.
 - (f) Interclass competitions will be organized.
 - (g) The services hours of students can be seen in school homepage.
7. Student can get an application form from General Office or download from school homepage. The application form should be filled the name of organization / teachers, date and hours of service, signature / chop of organization or teachers. The application must be returned to General Office and school will make decision to approve and the data will be input by General Office.

F. Civic Education

1. We promote good citizenship through festivals and other campaigns because of their underlying meaning
2. Festivals are such as Happy Mothers / Fathers Day, Ching Ming, Chung Yeung, Mid-Autumn Festival, Union Nation xxx Days.
