S1E Film Viewing of *Alice in Wonderland*

On Wednesday, 10 March 2010, from 3:00 to 6:00 p.m., the S1E English teacher —Mr. Todd Smith and Ms Julie Delisle—will be taking the S1E students to Olympian City 2 to watch the film version of *Alice in Wonderland*.

This film viewing is from Walt Disney Pictures and visionary director Tim Burton. It is a 3D fantasy adventure ALICE IN WONDERLAND, a magical and imaginative twist on some of the most beloved stories of all time. JOHNNY DEPP stars as the Mad Hatter and MIA WASIKOWSKA as 19-year-old Alice, who returns to the whimsical world she first encountered as a young girl, reuniting with her childhood friends: the White Rabbit, Tweedledee and Tweedledum, the Dormouse, the Caterpillar, the Cheshire Cat, and of course, the Mad Hatter. Alice embarks on a fantastical journey to find her true destiny and end the Red Queen's reign of terror. It is our firm belief that this will generate further discussions regarding the faithfulness of the film to the novel as well as the challenges in transforming a novel into a film.


The school will provide subsidy to students and the students will be asked to pay HK\$20 each for the film ticket. Should the students decide to watch on their own, they will likely be paying at least HK\$50-HK\$55 plus MTR or other public transportation costs. Thus, the students can save more than half of the actual cost of watching the film on their own.

Students and teachers will leave school together and take the MTR to Olympian City at 3:00 p.m. after classes are over. Students are requested to make arrangements for their travel home at 6:00 p.m. While this film viewing is entirely optional, it is our hope that your child/ward will participate together with their class.
