為了更有效及廣泛地令更多少數族裔家長能獲取足夠資訊以在子女的教育中作出知情的選擇，融樂會首次製作了「融樂會家長教育短片系列」，包括英語、烏爾都語/印地語及尼泊爾語六條短片，向家長簡介本地教育制度、報讀幼稚園/小學及中學的程序、與少數族裔相關的教育支援及政策等。

To empower ethnic minority parents to make informed decisions, Unison launched the first of its kind video series titled "You, Your Child and School". The first series has 6 videos in 3 languages namely English, Urdu/Hindi and Nepali. The series explains to parents the basics of the Hong Kong education system, the school application procedures for kindergarten, primary and secondary schools, as well as government policies for ethnic minorities.
