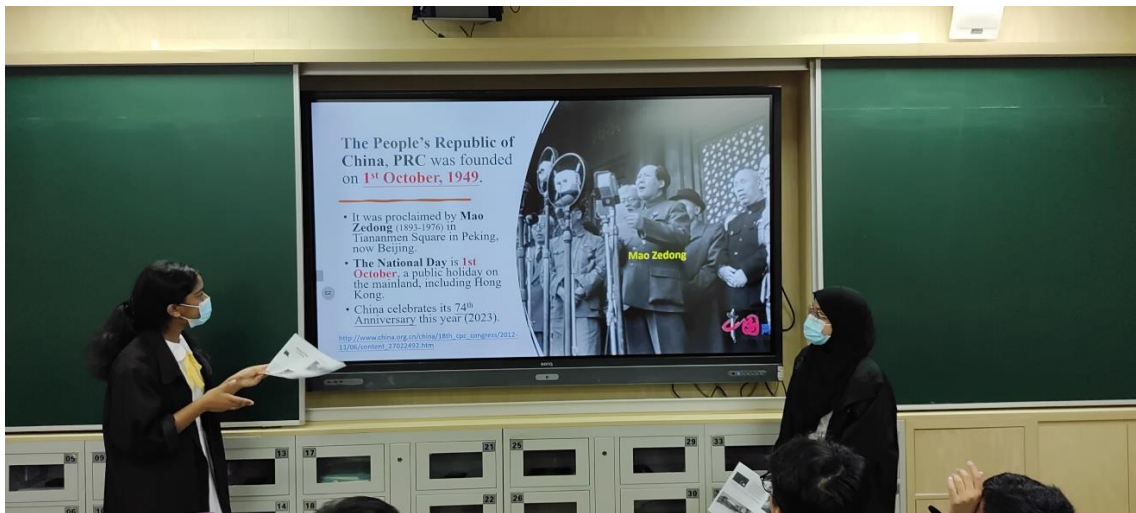


Students in People's Great Hall (2006)

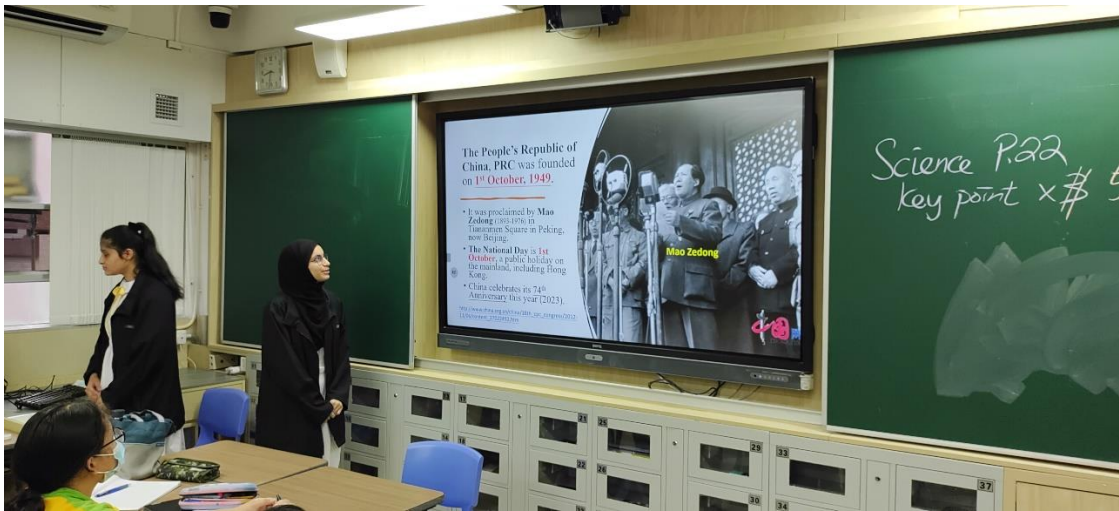
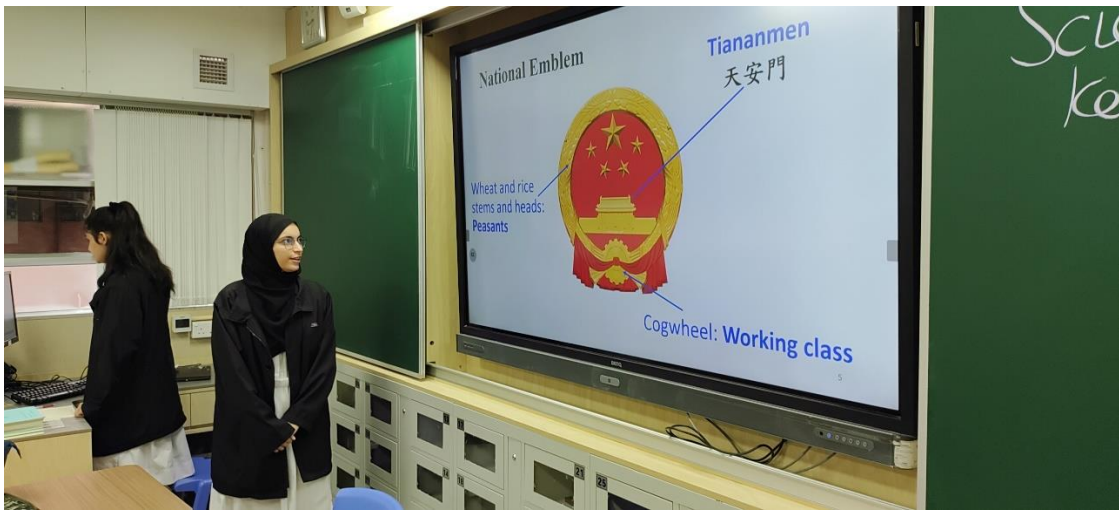


Broadway teachers and students at a site of the Great Wall (2006)

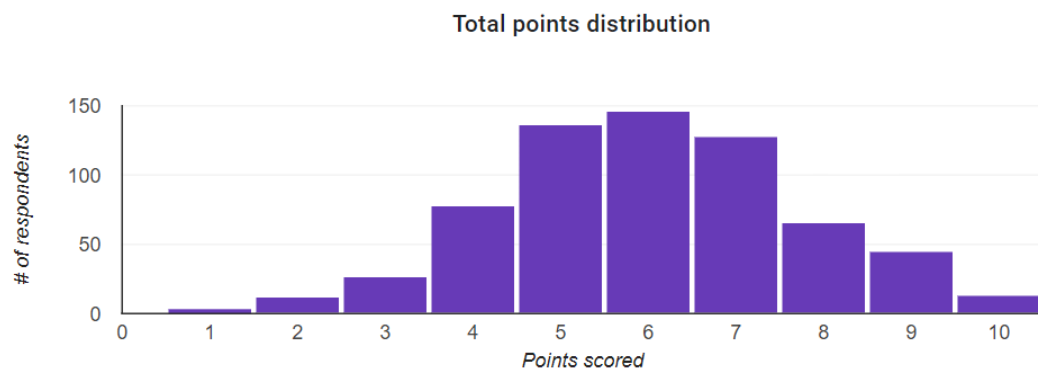

## Evaluation

Once again students are given the opportunity to know China more. Their basic understanding of China is once again reinforced. This year we have our own in-school online quiz instead of the one delivered by the EDB for the sake of better control of the coverage of the quiz content. This provides better feedback to us (see below). The mean score was 6.0 and it was satisfactory and it reflects the level of students' basic knowledge of China and Hong Kong. There is still room for improvement.

<b>Average</b> 6.01 / 10 points	<b>Median</b> 6 / 10 points	<b>Range</b> 1 - 10 points
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Students helpers were enlisted to deliver the presentation. It aimed at deepening their knowledge of China first as well as their generic skills. With their help, other students' knowledge of China is consolidated.
