Since its inception in 2012, this program has been instrumental in helping participants develop essential life skills, resilience, and creative abilities in photography. What sets RiseUp! apart is that it provides a platform for young individuals to express their experiences, identity, and how they overcome life's challenges through the captivating medium of photography. Sponsored by BNP Paribas, this program is entirely FREE, with English as the main language of instruction.

Programme Objectives:

- Photography Skills: Equip young participants with photography skills through storytelling training and advanced tools.
- Peer Support: Create peer support networks within Ethnic Minority youth participants to foster empowerment within their communities.
- Mentorship: Connect Ethnic Minority youth with mentors who have played a significant role in advocating for more inclusive and caring communities in Hong Kong to collaborate on a photography project.
