Objectives:

Learning Assessment

- There will be continuing assessment after each lesson in order to consolidate what the students have learned.
- At the end of the course, non-Chinese speaking students have to take the Hanyu Shuiping Kaoshi (HSK), a PTH test for non-Chinese speaking learners. Certificates will be awarded to candidates passing the required standard.
- In the Program Completion Ceremony, all students have to participate in a performance using Putonghua to show what they have learned in the program. The performance can be in various styles, e.g. drama or singing etc.

9:30 – 11:00	Visit the Nanyue Kingdom Palace Museum (Exhibition with English subtitle) The Nanyue Kingdom Palace Museum is built over the archaeological site of the Nanyue Kingdom Palace, which is a Major Historical and Cultural Site Protected at the National Level.
11:00 – 14:00	Visit Beijing Road Pedestrian Street Beijing Road Pedestrian Street is a pedestrian street where has absolutely everything; cheap clothes, good food and even a little history. There is a display of the original road from the song dynasty (960 – 1279 A.D). Lunch at Beijing Road Pedestrian Street Students accompanied by supervisors and helpers can have lunch at the fast food shops and restaurants there.
14:00	Gather at the Beijing Road Pedestrian Street
14:30	Depart and arrive at Yuexiu Park Station by subway in 15 minutes.
14:30 – 15:35	Visit the Museum of Nan Yue King (Exhibition with English subtitle) The museum, formerly the tomb of the second king of Nan Yue, was unearthed in 1983 and became a museum. There are over 10,000 pieces of excavation for exhibition, showing the historical value of culture and arts of southern China two thousand years ago.
15:40	Gather at the entrance of Museum of the Nan Yue King and head to Yuexiu Park station for subway back to SYSU.
16:30	Arrival at Sun Yat-sen University

Items to bring along : Umbrella, cap, drinking water, heat-stroke prevention medicine, mosquito repellent, backpack, camera, wallet, mobile phone, notebook and relevant documents.

Instructions to Students

General Rules

- The PTH Summer Camp is for learning and cultural exchange purposes. Students should participate in all activities with proper attitude, i.e., respect, collaboration, mutual help and friendship-building.
- Always be courteous and harmonious with people. Be tolerant and respectful of the habits and customs of the local people.
- Students are ambassadors for Hong Kong and the School, so always mind your words and manners.
- Students should always comply with the advice of the teacher supervisors and instructors. Do not leave the school campus or enter the rooms of classmates of the other gender.
- Always wear the camp badge for identification.
- Be cautious of your personal belongings. Always bring along precious articles wherever you go.

Travel Documents

- You should bring your student ID card and valid travel documents, including the Hong Kong permanent ID card, Travel Permit, passport with the Chinese visa. The chief supervisor will keep all students' travel documents after arriving and before leaving Guangzhou.
- Please let your parents keep the photocopies of your HK ID card and Travel Permit/ Passport with Chinese visa.

Luggage and articles for use (For reference only)

- Luggage size should not exceed 560mmx360mmx230mm
- Toiletries: comb, towel, handkerchief, tissue, toothpaste, shower gel/soap, shampoo, skincare cream, sun block, etc.
- Clothes for change: underwear, jeans, middle-length pants, T-shirt with sleeves, sneakers, sandals, spare shoes, etc.
- General medicine: e.g., Panadol or medicine for diarrhea, nausea, stomachache and mask, etc. Unless with prescription from the doctor, the camp supervisors will not provide any oral medication.
- Other articles: mobile phone, umbrella and/or raincoat, spare glasses, hair dryer and socket adaptor (with 2 or 3 flat prongs), camera, memory card, charger, needle and thread, rucksack, water jug, etc.
- Stationery: notebook, file, notepad, etc.

Making Calls

- The area code for long-distance calls to China is 0086.
- Long-distance calls from China to Hong Kong begin with 00852 + the Hong Kong telephone number.
- The charge for mobile with roaming is expensive. You may buy a Data Card in Hong Kong.
- Parents of students may call the supervisors to contact the students at telephone numbers on P.2.

Weather

- Guangzhou is humid, rainy and hot in July with an average temperature of 31⁰C. You may check the weather via the link below.

- When the weather is bad on the day of departure or return, e.g., the typhoon signal no. 8 is hoisted, or red/black rainstorm signal is in force, or class suspension is announced by the EDB, the trip will be postponed for one day. Students should ask chief supervisors for advice.

Clothing

- You are required to put on the school P.E. uniform for the trips of departure and return on the first and last days.
- You are required to put on proper school summer uniforms with white socks and black shoes for the Opening and Completion Ceremony.
- You may wear casual clothes for the rest of the time (do not wear vest, short pants and slippers).
- It is hot, humid and rainy in Guangzhou during the summer. You should bring enough clothes for change.
- You may use the bathroom for washing and drying your clothes in the hotel. Bring your own clothes hangers.
- You should spray mosquito repellent during outing. To avoid sunburn, you should use sun block, bring an umbrella or put on a hat when going out.

Canteen and Convenience Shop

- The canteen is open from 6:30 to 20:30. Three meals for one day is about RMB 60.
- Only meal coupons are accepted by the canteen for payment.
- The convenience shop in the hotel is open from 8:00 to 22:00 for purchase of necessities.
- Only RMB currency will be accepted for purchase in the convenience shop.

Drinking Water

- Drinking water will be provided by the hotel. Do not drink tap water.

Voltage

- The voltage in Guangzhou is 220V, the same as in Hong Kong. However, the socket with three flat prongs is different. You should bring an adaptor socket.
- When using an electric charger in the dormitory, make sure not to leave the room unattended and remember to check if the charger becomes too hot.

Mobile Phone

- You may bring your own mobile phone, but you should keep it safe from loss or theft.
- You may ask your teacher supervisor for permission to call your parent.
- Beware of bad weather when using a mobile phone in an open area.
- Put your mobile phone on silent mode during the lesson time, always keep the mobile phone on for communication with teacher supervisors and other students.

Currency

- RMB currency is used in Guangzhou. You are advised to bring not more than RMB 1500 (approximately HK\$1600) for meals and pocket money.

Time difference

- Both Guangzhou and Hong Kong are in the same time zone.

Health

- Maintain your health in good condition, keep a balanced diet and have sufficient rest.
- Do not eat excessively, oily food or food from street vendors outside campus.
- You should ask your teacher supervisor for help if you have a fever or if you are feeling unwell. Your supervisor will arrange medical consultation for you.
- You should request a receipt from the clinic as a proof for claiming insurance.
- Ask your teacher supervisor for a mask if you have a cold or flu.

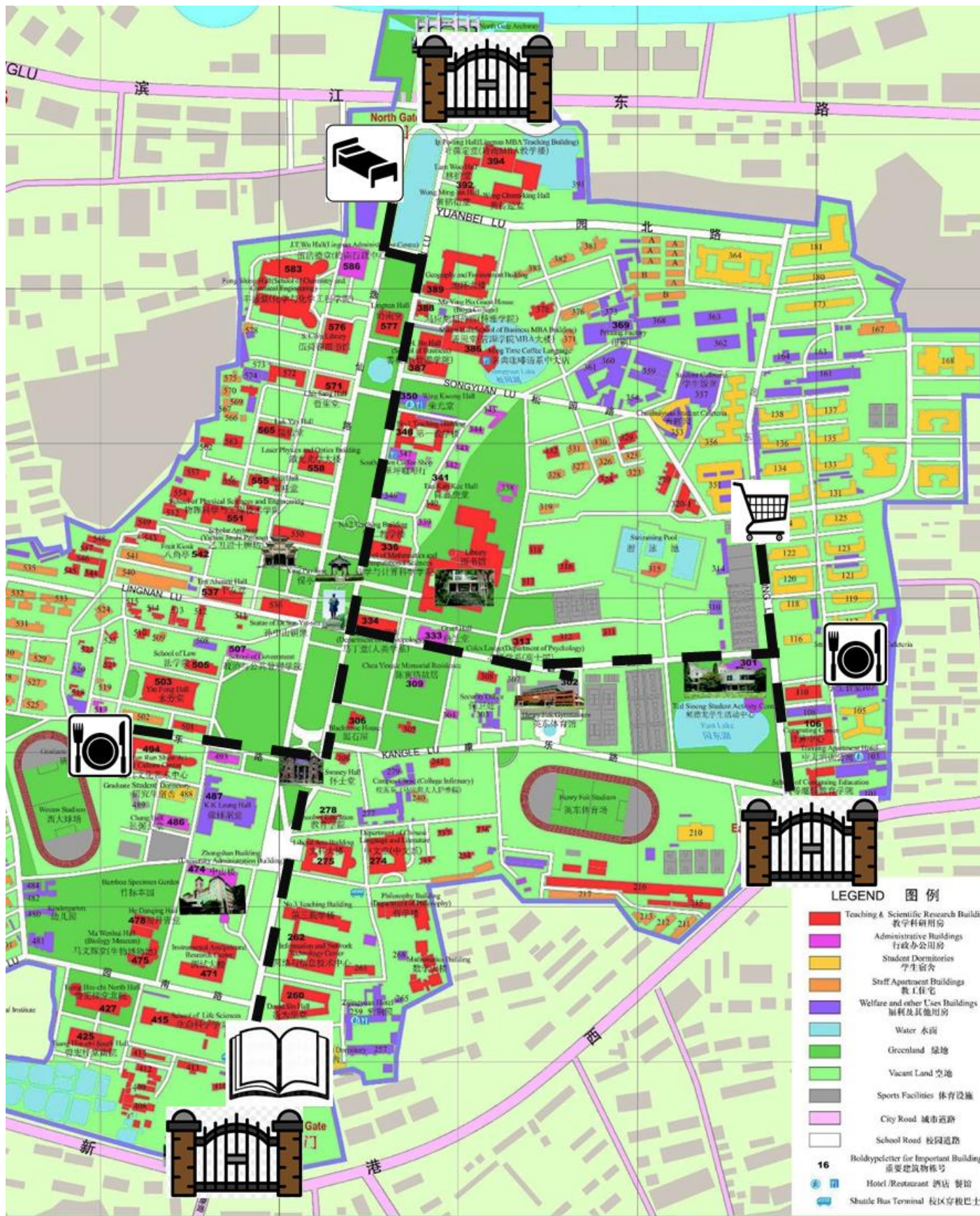
Campus life

- The walking distance from the hotel to canteen and lecture building should be within 20 minutes.
- You should return to the hotel room not later than 20:00. No one is allowed to leave the hotel after 21:30.
- You should take care of your personal belongings and keep the door and windows locked when leaving your room or when you are asleep inside.
- The bed sheet, blanket, pillow and pillowcase are provided by the hotel and you should tidy up the room regularly.
- Each dormitory is for 2 persons, with an en-suite bathroom. Students are responsible for keeping the room and the bathroom clean. There is a bed, a desk and a cupboard for each student.
- You should always keep the dormitory safe. Do not use electric appliances with high voltage requirements.
- Always keep contact with your group members and teacher supervisors. Be vigilant towards strangers.
- Under no circumstance should a boy enter a girl's room and vice versa.
- No change of room without the permission of the Supervisor is allowed.

Souvenir

- Students of each school should prepare two 'thank you' cards to present to the Center of Continuing Education of Sun Yat-sen University and the University teachers at the end of the Summer Camp.
