

## Visit to Green at Kwai Tsing

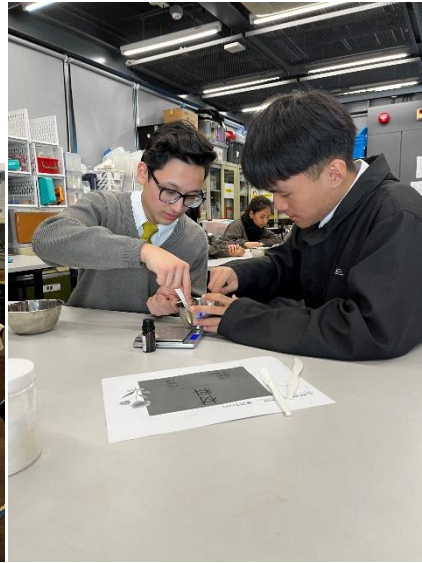
